The George M. Hampton Foundation is a public, non-profit organization, named after Dr. George M. Hampton, Lieutenant Colonel, U.S. Army (Retired), in honor of his lifelong legacy of public service commitment to support academic excellence and opportunities for students in the greater Prince William County and Stafford County areas. Dr. Hampton was a distinguished alumnus of North Carolina A&T University, a lifetime member of the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. and an infantry veteran of the Korean War. The Foundation is composed of volunteers with extensive experience in government and private industry. Since its establishment in 2005, the Foundation has dedicated itself, to serving the community where the need is greatest, through sponsorship and participation in various public service programs. A key Foundation initiative is its annual Continuing Education scholarship for Prince William County and Stafford County residents enrolled in a junior/community college or a four-year college/university. This is a \$1,000 scholarship that will go to the first-place winner.

APPLICANTS MUST

- Be residents of Greater Prince William County and Stafford County,
- Be enrolled in college (above locations not required) spring semester 2025
- *Enroll in a junior/community college or 4-year college/university for the fall semester of 2025
- Have a minimum, cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Sign and submit the certification statement on page 3 along with their application

* Fall semester begins in August/September of 2025 and ends in December of 2025
