Who is Gene Montague and why is this event named for him?

Eugene "Gene" Montague was born in Brooklyn, NY, was a retired New York City Police Officer and rose to the rank of Colonel in the U.S. Army Reserve. Gene passed away on May 22, 2016, in the excitement of doing what he loved to do - staying fit while participating in competitive physical activity.

As a high school student, Gene participated on the track team and his interest in joining the armed services began to grow. He would later graduate from the City University of New York with a Bachelor's in Psychology, having participated in the ROTC program and becoming an Army Reserve Officer. Gene earned a Master of Science degree in Business Administration and Management from Central Michigan University. In 1987, while completing his undergraduate study, Gene joined Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Incorporated through Epsilon Chapter in New York with his five line brothers. Together, they were the Sagacious Six Sons of Destiny.

In 1989 he began studying Sanuces Ryu, a form of Jiu-Jitsu, and would practice for the next 27 years. Gene would earn the title of Shihan (Master Teacher) and rise to the rank of 6th Degree Black Belt. Gene joined the NYPD in 1990, working for Precincts in Fort Green, Brooklyn, Harlem and Washington Heights. He later became an instructor at the Police Academy before eventually going to the 83rd Precinct in Bushwick, Brooklyn. Gene met the love of his life, Lissette, and they married in 1994. For the next 23 years, they would build a life of love and friendship together and would have three incredible children, Aminah, Ahmad and Aza; joined by their older brother Eugene III. Gene retired from the force in 1997 from injuries sustained in the line of duty.

Gene began his military career in 1988, commissioning as an Infantryman and spending the next 28 years in a host of positions from New York to Germany, serving in combat zones in Kosovo and Afghanistan, and last serving as the Deputy G-3/5/7 for the Office of the Chief Army Reserve in Ft. Belvoir.

Gene is a decorated Army officer, having received numerous decorations and badges: the Defense Meritorious Service Medal with one Oak Leaf Cluster (OLC), the Meritorious Service Medal with two Oak Leaf Clusters, the Joint Service Commendation Medal, the Army Commendation Medal, the Army Achievement Medal with four OLCs, the Joint Meritorious Unit Award with two OLC, the Army Meritorious Unit Commendation and Army Superior Unit Award, the National Defense Service Medal with Bronze Service Star Device, the Afghanistan Campaign Medal with Bronze Star Device, the Kosovo Campaign Medal with Bronze Service Star Device, the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, the NATO Medal with Bronze Service Star Device (Kosovo Operations and International Security Assistance Force in Afghanistan), the Expert Infantryman's Badge, the Basic Parachutist Badge, Honduran Airborne Wings and German Parachutist Badge (Bronze), the Joint Staff Identification Badge and Army Staff Identification Badge.
